

## In order to enjoy this Natural Protected Area and to help protect it, don't forget:

-  Before starting the visit, find out about the possibilities offered in the Area in accordance with your interests and capabilities.
-  Do not leave the marked paths, so that you do not disturb the fauna and you can appreciate the splendour of the landscape better. Access to certain paths is restricted. Pay attention to the signposts.
-  Being quiet will allow you to observe the fauna. Remember to take binoculars in order to appreciate all its beauty. Observe the flora without damaging it or picking it, so that we can all continue to enjoy it in the same way.
-  After your visit, remember to pick up any rubbish you may have and put it in the bin.
-  Do not throw rubbish or use soaps or any other detergents in fountains, rivers or any other flowing water.
-  Only high mountain camping is allowed in the Natural Park at altitudes higher than 2,000 m, between 20 h and 8 h, and more than 500 m from a refuge.
-  Lighting fires is not allowed. If you see smoke or anything unusual, call 112 (SOS Aragón). The call is free and any emergency will be attended to.
-  Summer storms and sudden drops in temperature are common. It is recommendable to always take warm clothes and waterproofs. Find out about the weather forecast before planning your activities.



## Access and parking regulations





Posets-Maladeta Natural Park is one of the most important Protected Natural Spaces in Aragón. The impressiveness of its high mountain landscapes of the Aragon Pyrenees is an attraction for an increasingly higher number of visitors.

In order to conserve the ecosystems and landscapes of the Natural Park, and to increase the security in the mountains, it is necessary to establish regulations for the access and circulation of visitors.

To be precise, access with a motorized vehicle to the spot called La Besurta and to the Vallibierna valley is restricted in the busiest seasons of the year (end of June until mid-September), in order to avoid risky situations, crowds and possibly negative incidents in the natural environment.

Benasque Town Hall, during this period of restriction, offers a public transport service in order to access these enclaves.
